

## Probate Notes for January 16, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Cathcart**  
**Case No. CV PB 03-169**

It is recommended to grant the petition for an order authorizing medical treatment for the conservatee. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5358.2.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Jiminez**  
**Case No. CV PC 11-212**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, January 30, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Mihalisin**  
**Case No. CV PC 13-221**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, January 30, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Santiago**  
**Case No. CV PC 01-36**

It is recommended to approve the verified third account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Siegel**  
**Case No. CV PC 14-140**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for brief testimony regarding dementia powers and capacity to consent to medical treatment as ordered by the Court on November 21, 2014.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Turnbull**  
**Case No. CV PC 11-207**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, March 6, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:           Conservatorship of Wilder**  
**Case No. CV PC 13-177**

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law.

The conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on May 5, 2014. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)

**CASE:           LPS Conservatorship of Alemu**  
**Case No. LP SQ 12-01**

It is recommended to approve the verified third account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE:           LPS Conservatorship of Brown**  
**Case No. LP SQ 08-43**

The Court notes the following deficiency: The petition is missing one of the required affidavits from a licensed physician and/or psychologist stating that the conservatee is still gravely disabled. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

**CASE:           LPS Conservatorship of Hammidi**  
**Case No. LP SQ 14-54**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of conservator of the person and the estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
