

Probate Notes for June 18, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Hoyt
Case No. CV PC 12-139

It is recommended to approve the second verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Pierson
Case No. CV PB 06-95

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and Christina Griffiths' fourth and final verified account and report of trustee. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

It is also recommended to grant Tamara McDaniel's petition for issuance of amended letters of conservatorship of the person. (Prob. Code, § 2310.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Cafarelli
Case No. CV P2 95-17646

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Thursday July 23, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 so that the Court may more thoroughly consider the petitions filed by Kavanaugh Cafarelli and Carolyn Young.

CASE: Estate of Chaudhary
Case No. CV P2 15-94

It is recommended to grant the spousal property petition. (Prob. Code, § 13650 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
