

## Probate Notes for June 25, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE: Estate of Moya**  
**Case No. CV PB 13-196**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Catherine Rodriguez's petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, as ordered by the Court on June 4, 2015.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Verma**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-73**

It is recommended to deny Mishri Lal Verma's petition for appointment of conservator of the person of Nihal Devi, based on the recommendations in the court investigator's report. Additionally, the Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)
2. The notice of hearing filed on April 22, 2015, does not comply with Code of Civil Procedure section 1013a. Petitioner served the notice and he is a party to the action.
3. A Capacity Declaration (form GC-335) has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, §§ 1881, 1890.)
