

## Probate Notes for April 10, 2017

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Bauch**  
**Case No. CV PC 17-59**

It is recommended to provisionally grant the petition to accept transfer of the conservatorship. (Prob. Code, § 2002, subd. (f).)

**CASE:            In the Matter of the Softky Trust**  
**Case No. CV P2 16-219**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Monday, May 1, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 7 to be heard together with Karen Elizabeth Jones's first account and report of trustee and petitions for approval of: (1) account and report, (2) acts of the trustee, (3) distributions, (4) charitable trust gifts, (5) compensation to trustee and her agents, and petition for order authorizing the sale of real property.

Should the continued hearing date be inconvenient for any party, the party shall meet and confer with all parties and contact the Court at (530) 406-6838 to arrange an alternative date agreed upon by all parties. If the parties cannot agree, then the Court's selected hearing date for the continued motion is confirmed.
