

## **Probate Notes for April 13, 2017**

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Guimaraes**  
**Case No. CV PC 17-52**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)
2. Petitioners fail to list the names, addresses, and relationship of all relatives within the second degree in Paragraph 11. Specifically, the proposed conservatee's children and grandchildren are not listed as required. (Petition, ¶ 11.)
3. Proof that the notice of hearing has been served on the required parties, has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1822 (1827.5.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Strickland**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-176**

It is recommended to deny without prejudice, Rory Dan Strickland's verified petition for order authorizing payment of attorney fees and reimbursement of costs incurred in establishing conservatorship and appointment of successor trustee. The petition may not be filed sooner than 90 days following the issuance of letters to the conservator appointed. (Prob Code, §2640.1, subd. (a).)

**CASE:            Estate of Ali**  
**Case No. CV P2 17-80**

It is recommended to grant the spousal property petition. (Prob. Code, § 13650 et seq.)
