

Probate Notes for April 14, 2017

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Seven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Kofoid
Case No. CV PC 08-212

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the review hearing as ordered by the court on February 22, 2017.

CASE: Conservatorship of Nelson
Case No. CV PC 17-66

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Salmeri
Case No. CV PC 07-214

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, December 8, 2009.

It is recommended to approve the verified second and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Ruiz
Case No. CV P2 17-12

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Attachment 11 does not include decedent's interest in the property. (Petition, ¶ 11.)
2. Paragraph 13 does not state the specific property interest claimed by each petitioner in the real property, as required. (Petition, ¶ 13.)

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Bowman
Case No. LP SQ 11-67**

It is recommended to approve the verified first and final account and report of the conservator and petition for discharge of the LPS conservator of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Kim
Case No. LP SQ 12-35**

It is recommended to approve the verified third and final account and report of the conservator and petition for discharge of the LPS conservator of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Monson-Bennett
Case No. LP SQ 17-08**

The Court notes the following deficiencies: The comprehensive report of the conservatorship investigating officer has not been filed with the Court and served on the requesting physician, proposed conservator, and proposed conservatee, as required. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5354 et seq.)

**CASE: In the Matter of Gelber
Case No. LP SQ 01-04**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.** (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 6500 et seq.)
