

## Probate Notes for April 17, 2017

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Wagers**  
**Case No. CV PC 03-300**

The Court notes the following deficiency: Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)

Additionally, as the conservatorship has not been reviewed since 2003, on the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, May 19, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 7 for completion of the court investigator's report.

Should the continued hearing date be inconvenient for any party, the party shall meet and confer with all parties and contact the Court at (530) 406-6838 to arrange an alternative date agreed upon by all parties. The alternative hearing date shall be set no earlier than Friday, May 19, 2017. If the parties cannot agree, then the Court's selected hearing date is confirmed.

Petitioner's Matthew and Andrea Wagers may appear by Court Call for the continued hearing.

**CASE:            Estate of Latimer**  
**Case No. CV PB 17-69**

It is recommended to grant the petition for probate of will and letters testamentary and for authorization to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8200.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
