

Probate Notes for April 25, 2017

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Seven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Barth
Case No. CV PC 14-192

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Thursday, May 25, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 7 for completion of the court investigator's report.

Should the continued hearing date be inconvenient for any party, the party shall meet and confer with all parties and contact the Court at (530) 406-6838 to arrange an alternative date agreed upon by all parties. The alternative hearing date shall be set no earlier than Thursday, May 25, 2017. If the parties cannot agree, then the Court's selected hearing date is confirmed.

CASE: Estate of Bobb
Case No. CV PB 16-172

It is recommended to approve the first and final report on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petitions for allowance of compensation to the attorney for the personal representative in the amount requested for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Dallacosta
Case No. CV PB 17-64

It is recommended to grant the petition for probate of will and letters testamentary and for authorization to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8200.)
