TENTATIVE RULING

Case: Costa v. Contreras
Case No. CV CV 14-745
Hearing Date: December 11, 2014 **Department Two** **9:00 a.m.**

Plaintiffs Thomas Costa and Gwendolyn Costa's motion for leave to file a second amended complaint is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 473, subd. (a)(1).) Defendant Romeo Berrettoni Trust does not demonstrate any prejudice from allowing the amendment. (*Morgan v. Superior Court* (1959) 172 Cal.App.2d 527, 530.)

Having permitted the filing of the second amended complaint, defendant's motion to strike portions of the first amended complaint is **DROPPED AS MOOT**.

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
