TENTATIVE RULING

Case: **Devor v. Char**

Plaintiff Todd Devore's motion to compel verified responses to general form interrogatories from defendant Cheryl Char dba Subway ("defendant") is **DENIED AS MOOT**, since defendant has now provided verified responses. However, because the Court finds that defendant lacked substantial justification for failing to provide a verification when requested by plaintiff, the Court imposes a monetary sanction in the amount of \$485.00 on defendant. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2030.300, subd. (d); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1348(a).)

Plaintiff's motion to compel verified responses to employment form interrogatories from defendant **DENIED AS MOOT**, since defendant has now provided verified responses. However, because the Court finds that defendant lacked substantial justification for failing to provide a verification when requested by plaintiff, the Court imposes a monetary sanction in the amount of \$485.00 on defendant. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2030.300, subd. (d); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1348(a).)

Plaintiff's motion to compel further and verified responses to special interrogatories from defendant is **DENIED AS MOOT**, since defendant has now provided verified further responses. However, because the Court finds that defendant lacked substantial justification for failing to provide a verification and further responses when requested by plaintiff, the Court imposes a monetary sanction in the amount of \$485.00 on defendant. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2030.300, subd. (d); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1348(a).)

Plaintiff's motion to compel further and verified responses to requests for production from defendant is **DENIED AS MOOT**, since defendant has now provided verified further responses. However, because the Court finds that defendant lacked substantial justification for failing to provide a verification and further responses when requested by plaintiff, the Court imposes a monetary sanction in the amount of \$1,335.00 on defendant. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2031.310, subd. (h); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1348(a).)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
