

## **Probate Notes for April 28, 2016**

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Gordon**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-31**

The Court notes the following deficiency: The capacity declaration (form GC-335) filed on March 28, 2016, is incomplete as item 7(b) is not initialed by the declarant.

**CASE:            Estate of Painter**  
**Case No. CV PB 14-145**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. A proof of service for the notice of hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 11000.)
2. Petitioner states that Erika Edgerley Robbins is entitled to distribution of the estate and that her waiver of accounting has been filed. (Petition, ¶ 11.) A waiver of accounting has not been filed with the Court. Further, it is unclear what distribution Ms. Robbins is entitled to as she is not named in decedent's will and she has not been provided with notice of these proceedings.

**CASE:            Estate of Wadlin**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-66**

The Court notes the following deficiency: A proof of service for the notice of hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 11000.) Additionally, petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
