After-Hours Court-Relief on Election Day (Tuesday, June 7th, 2016)

If you need to request immediate court action to protect important rights on Election Day, Tuesday, June 7th, 2016 *after* the court's regular business hours, please call or visit the Office of the County Registrar of Voters. If election laws do not provide an immediate solution, the County Registrar of Voters will help you contact Superior Court officials so that you may present your request to a Judge.
