Notice of Limited Interpreter Availability for Family Law Cases

As of June 1st, 2016, Interpreters will be provided in family case types four (4) days per month, the 1st and 3rd Thursday at 1:30 pm for Department 3 and the 2nd and 4th Thursday at 1:30 pm for Department 4. Interpreters will continue to be provided in Domestic Violence Temporary Restraining Order (DVTRO), Domestic Violence Protective Order (DVPO), Guardianships, Conservatorships and UD cases as needed, provided the interpreter has been requested in advance. Court Interpreters will be provided for in-court interpretation.

If an interpreter is required in a Family Matter that is not for a DVTRO or DVPO, please request an interpreter through the courts website at www.yolo.courts.ca.gov, by using a Family Non-DV Interpreter Request Form or make a request at the Service Windows or through the FLF/SH Center.

If it a DVTRO or DVPO case, please use the Interpreter Request form for Criminal, DVTRO and DVPO, Guardianships, Conservatorships and UD cases available online.

A request for an interpreter must be made in advance. A request for Spanish interpreter must be received at least (3) days prior to the date of service, five (5) days for all other languages.

DVTRO, DVPO, Guardianships, Conservatorships and UD cases that require an interpreter will continue to be scheduled as needed and not on specific interpreter days. An Interpreter Request must be made online or at the Service Windows or FLF/SH Center. If an interpreter is not requested in advance, and interpreter may not be available.
