

Probate Notes for April 18, 2017

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Seven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Estate of Camarena
Case No. CV P2 17-65

The Court notes the following deficiency: Attachment 11 fails to state the interest held by decedent in the described property. (Petition, ¶ 11.)

CASE: The Barth Declaration of Trust
Case No. CV P2 16-157

Petitioner has failed to file a copy of the Declaration of Trust Division dated March 16, 2006 mentioned in Paragraph 4 of the Petition. (“Declaration”). Petitioner is directed to file a copy of the Declaration with the Court no later than by April 26, 2017.

On the Court’s own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Tuesday, May 16, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 7 so that the Court may more thoroughly consider the petition filed by Thomas Barth.

Should the continued hearing date be inconvenient for any party, the party shall meet and confer with all parties and contact the Court at (530) 406-6838 to arrange an alternative date agreed upon by all parties. If the parties cannot agree, then the Court’s selected hearing date for the continued motion is confirmed.
