

Probate Notes for January 3, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matters will be heard at **9:00 a.m.** in the department indicated below.

The following probate matters will be heard in Department 8.

CASE: Estate of Mark
Case No. CV PB 17-90

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner fails to state whether notice was given or was required under Probate Code section 9201.
2. Petitioner fails to state the required information for filed creditor claims. (Prob. Code., § 10900, subd. (b)(2).)
3. The petition does not include the information required for the sale of the house. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.250(a).)

CASE: Estate of Warne
Case No. CV PB 18-258

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner is directed to file a copy of the Herbert R. Warne and Margaret I. Warne Revocable Living Trust, established on August 8, 1991, with the Court, so that it may determine if notice has been provided to all beneficiaries as required. (Prob. Code., § 1208, subd. (b).)
2. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

The following probate matters will be heard in Department 12.

CASE: Estate of Arleo
Case No. CV PB 08-137

It is recommended to approve the verified fifth account and report on status of administration. (Prob. Code, § 1060 et seq., 10900 et seq.)

CASE: Matter of Vidales
Case No. CV P2 18-238

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to January 17, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 12.
