

Probate Notes for January 4, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Camacho
Case No. LP SQ 13-65

It is recommended to approve the verified fifth account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

Petitioner shall submit a proposed order prior to the hearing.

CASE: Matter of Eckels
Case No. CV P2 18-19

It is recommended to grant Pearl A. McGuire's petition for an order determining that title to real property in the name of Donald E. Eckles [sic], deceased and Pearl A. McGuire is the property of Pearl A. McGuire as surviving joint tenant. (Prob. Code, § 850, subd. (a)(2)(C); Civ. Code, §§ 1066, 3399; *Jones v. First American Title Ins. Co.* (2003) 107 Cal.App.4th 381, as modified on denial of reh. April 23, 2003.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Talamantes
Case No. LP SQ 16-53

It is recommended to approve the verified second account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

Petitioner shall submit a proposed order prior to the hearing.

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Vogt
Case No. LP SQ 13-63

It is recommended to approve the verified fifth account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
