

Probate Notes for January 16, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: Unless otherwise noted, the following probate matters will be heard in **Department Ten at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Estate of Pluto
Case No. CV PB 19-273

This probate matter will be heard in **Department Nine.**

It is recommended to grant the petition for probate of will and letters testamentary and for authorization to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Willey
Case No. CV PB 19-274

It is recommended to grant the petition for letters of administration, and for full authority under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.)

CASE: Matter of Williams Trust
Case No. CV P2 19-270

It is recommended to grant petitioner Helen M.W. Harris' petition for confirmation of appointment of successor trustee.
