

Probate Notes for January 23, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Ten at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Backhaus
Case No. CV PB 3-142

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Thursday, March 5, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 10 for completion of the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 2684.)

The Court also notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner failed to file an inventory and appraisal of the estate as required. (Prob. Code, § 2610.)
2. Petitioner fails to provide a summary of account using the mandatory Judicial Council Form GC-400SUM.
3. The requisite original billing statements for the residential care facility have not been filed with the court. (Prob. Code, § 2620, subd. (c)(5).)

CASE: Estate of Schwarzgruber
Case No. CV PB 19-176

It is recommended to approve the first and final report on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for the executor for ordinary services, for costs advanced by the attorney, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
