

Probate Notes for May 21, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Limited Conservatorship of Phillips
Case No. CV PC 18-96

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report for continuation of the limited conservatorship. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set biennial review for May 20, 2022.

It is recommended to waive reimbursement of \$450 to the Court for the court investigator's report.

CASE: Conservatorship of Hedge

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
