

Probate Notes for June 5, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Limited Conservatorship of Burger
Case No. CV PC 16-171

This probate matter will be heard in **Department Nine**.

The Court has not received any new filings since the last hearing of March 13, 2020. In order to issue a final order confirming the transfer and terminating the conservatorship, the Court must confirm receipt of (1) a provisional order accepting the proceeding from the court in Alaska and (2) the documents required to terminate a conservatorship in this state. (Prob. Code, § 2001, subd. (g)(1) and (2).)

CASE: Estate of Bustillos

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report for continuation of the conservatorship. (Probate Code §§ 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for June 5, 2022.

It is recommended to waive reimbursement of court investigator's fee based on the court's prior fee waiver.

**CASE: Limited Conservatorship of Drake
