

Probate Notes for June 29, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Estate of Collins

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of executor and to grant the petitions for statutory compensation to the executor and attorney for executor for ordinary services, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

Parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**

CASE: Matter of Stevens Trust
Case No. CV P2 19-234

It is recommended to grant petitioner Judy L. Stevens Sharp's petition for approval of the stipulation for order instructing trustee as to manner of distribution of trust assets. (Prob. Code, § 17200.)
