

Probate Notes for August 5, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

NOTICE: Effective May 4, 2020, all court appearances are by Zoom or Conference call. Yolo Superior Court Virtual Courtroom and conference call information is posted on the Yolo Court's Website at www.yolo.courts.ca.gov.

CASE: **Matter of Ide**
 Case No. CVP2 20-108

It is recommended to grant petitioner's request to confirm successor trustee. (Prob. Code, § 17200.)

For the *Heggstad* petition, the Court notes the following deficiency: petitioner has failed to file proof the *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council of California Form DE-115) and a copy of the petition were served on the required parties at least 30 days prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 851.)
