

Probate Notes for August 11, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

NOTICE: Effective May 4, 2020, all court appearances are by Zoom or Conference call. Yolo Superior Court Virtual Courtroom and conference call information is posted on the Yolo Court's Website at www.yolo.courts.ca.gov.

CASE: **Conservatorship of Glover**
 Case No. CVPC 19-54

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, September 25, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in Department Ten for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: **Conservatorship of Cole**
 Case No. CVPC 19-77

Parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR**.

CASE: **Estate of Lowe**
 Case No. CVPB 20-123

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner has not filed proof that the *Notice of Petition to Administer Estate* (Judicial Council form DE-121) has been served on the required individuals. (Prob. Code, § 8110.)
2. Petitioner has failed to file written bond waivers from each beneficiary as alleged in/required by paragraph 3(e) of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8481.)
3. The petition does not state the required information for each heir of the decedent. (Prob. Code, § 8002, subd. (a)(3); Petition, ¶ 8.)
4. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

Parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR**.

**CASE: Estate of McGrew
Case No. CVPB 17-107**

It is recommended to approve the second and final report on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petitions for allowance of the balance of statutory compensation to the administrator and attorney for the administrator for ordinary services, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
