

## Probate Notes for September 1, 2020

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:**           **Estate of Williams**  
                      **Case No. CVPB 20-128**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The original will has not been lodged with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 8200.)
2. Petitioner has not filed proof that the *Notice of Petition to Administer Estate* (Judicial Council form DE-121) has been served on the required individuals. (Prob. Code, § 8110.) The attachment with service list was omitted.
3. Paragraph eight of the petition does not list the names and required information for all persons mentioned in decedent's will as required. (Petition, ¶ 8.)

**CASE:**           **Estate of Pitzer**  
                      **Case No. CVPB 20-139**

The Court notes the following deficiency: The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-147).

Parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR**.

**CASE: Estate of Zamminer**  
**Case No. CVPB 20-135**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The original will has not been lodged with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 8200.)
2. A typed copy of the holographic will was not attached to the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8002, subd. (b)(1).)
3. The *Proof of Holographic Instrument* (Judicial Council Form DE-135) that was filed is incomplete. (Prob. Code, § 8222.) In addition, the Court notes that the proof was filled out by an interested party, the sole beneficiary.
