TENTATIVE RULING

Case: Barnes-Bradfield v. Whole Foods Market California, Inc.
Case No. CV PO 15-1062
Hearing Date: July 14, 2020 Department Ten 9:00 a.m.

Defendant Whole Food Market California, Inc.’s (“WFM”) motion to reconsider its motion for summary judgment is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., 1008, subd. (a).) Defendant has ten days to file the motion for reconsideration after written notice of entry of the order. (*Ibid.*) The Court’s tentative ruling states: “If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312 or further notice is required.” Therefore, no written notice of the entry of the order is required. Additionally, defendant was made aware of the Court’s ruling on May 8, 2020 but did not file the motion until June 17, 2020. (Dec. of Del Rio, § 5.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312 or further notice is required.

TENTATIVE RULING

Case: Rolle v. Craighton
Case No. CV CV 16-2033
Hearing Date: July 14, 2020 Department Nine 9:00 a.m.

Plaintiff Barbara Rolle, as trustee of the Rolle Family Trust’s motion to enforce consent decree and award attorney fees and costs is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 664.6.) Plaintiff has the full legal authority to unilaterally record the Consent Decree in the official records of the County of Yolo. (Consent Decree, ¶ 12.) Payment of \$1,000.00 from Defendants to Plaintiff’s counsel of record, for the easement is due within 10 days of the recording of the Consent Decree by Plaintiff. (*Id.*) Defendants shall pay plaintiff her attorney’s fees in the amount of \$3,200.00 and her costs in the amount of \$60.00 by July 31, 2020. (*Id.*, ¶ 14; Dec. of Caffrey, ¶¶ 5-8.) If

Plaintiff's counsel incurs additional fees to review Defendants' opposition and/or attend the hearing, the Court will address those additional fees at the hearing, if any. (Consent Decree, ¶ 14.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312 or further notice is required.
